Level 3 | Digital Business with Social Media Marketing in partnership with Pie Analysis



Shena Simon* | Two Years

Created in partnership with leading digital marketing agency Pie Analysis, this marketing business course is designed to give you the skills you'll need to succeed as a digital marketer or social media manager. You'll cover a wide range of topics, from content marketing and SEO to video advertising and much more.

You'll learn how to work with key stakeholders across a company to ensure messaging is coherent and on brand, and how to analyse results in order to tweak campaigns and reach new audiences.

Whether you're a social media pro or just starting out, this course will help you to take your skills to the next level.

Study for a Technical Level (T Level) qualification in Business Management and Finance

T Levels are a new two year technical programme that provide you with a high-quality alternative to A Levels.

They have been developed in collaboration with employers, and combine theory, practical and classroom learning with a minimum 45 day industry placement. If you opt to take a T Level you will spend 20% of your time on an industry placement and 80% in the classroom.

After completing the course you can progress directly into work, on to a Higher Apprenticeship or even move on to study a university degree, as T Levels are awarded UCAS points.




T Award

Courses

Level 3 | T Level | Business Management and Administration Shena Simon* | Two Years

If you have a brain for business and love getting stuck into the details of planning and management, then our Business Management and Administration T Level could be perfect for you.

You'll learn about large organisational structures and their event management processes while learning how to project manage more effectively. We'll help you to develop your leadership skills, financial management awareness and planning strategies needed for modern day business. As well as all that, you'll also study topics including Business Context, Quality Compliance and Change Management.

Level 3 | T Level | Finance Shena Simon* | Two Years

The financial services industry is one of the largest employers in the UK. It is a diverse industry covering areas such as banking, insurance, and wealth management. Money, protecting our assets and our future wealth are important to all of us. This is a fantastic industry with growing opportunities, calling for a variety of skills from its staff.

This course will help you develop an understanding of a broad range of issues relevant to the sector, including; the business environment, fundamentals of financial accounting, data driven innovation, analytics, design thinking and professionalism and ethics.



For those who don't meet the entry requirements and would still like to pursue a T Level, there is the option of a one-year Level 2 T Level Foundation Year as part of our Industry Excellence Academy for Business.

This Foundation Year will allow you to gain a qualification and move on to study one of our T Levels the following year.

Level 2 | T Level Foundation Year | Business Management and Finance Shena Simon* | One Year

You'll learn how businesses are structured whilst gaining valuable industry skills by studying the key areas that employers are currently looking for including organisational structures, event management, project management, leadership skills and finance as well as undertaking an industry placement.

Once you complete the qualification you'll be ready to progress on to a Business Management and Finance T Level the following year.


Jump Start To T Levels

Both our T Levels and T Level Foundation Year require you to complete our Jump Start to T Levels programme as an entry requirement.

This programme is a two-week introduction to our Industry Excellence Academy, T Level and T Level Foundation Year programmes, where you can meet your tutors and experience what studying a T Level at The Manchester College is like.

We passionately believe in helping you reach your ultimate goal, focusing on your future employability and developing the skills you need to have a successful career.

If you're aged 16-18, our Centre of Excellence for Business is set up to help you do just that!

Study Programme

You'll join our Centre of Excellence for Business when you enrol on any of our qualifications at Level 1, Level 2 or Level 3.

If you haven't already obtained a Grade 4 GCSE or the equivalent Functional Skills at Level 2 in English or maths, you'll study to achieve this level of qualification alongside your course. If you have a Grade 3, you will study a GCSE resit.

Alternatively, if you have anything lower than a Grade 3 then we will help you to develop your English and maths through Functional Skills.

This is a mandatory requirement and it's also essential that you achieve this for many careers and universities.



Employability

To prepare you for your future career, you'll take part in a range of 'employability' activities to equip you with knowledge and experience of careers available to you.

Employability Sessions

You'll be assigned an Employability Tutor and will take part in dedicated 'employability' sessions, which will help equip you with the skills you'll need to thrive in the workplace.

Work Experience Placement

If you join our Centre of Excellence you'll spend between 24 and 35 hours working in external workplaces across the region, while if you join our Industry Excellence Academy you'll complete at least 105 hours of work experience.

During your work experience you'll assist with day-to-day tasks and shadow staff to develop your skills and broaden your knowledge of the industry.

Industry Placement

You may be able to apply for an industry placement offering more than 315 hours of experience with a leading employer.

An industry placement gives you in-depth knowledge of the industry, allows you to gain hands-on experience and gives you an insight into career pathways.

With a placement, you're taking that all important first step onto the ladder; many of our students even go on to gain paid employment with their industry placement employer at the end of the year.

Work-Related Activity

You'll learn more about the world of business by taking part in a wide range of activities, such as:

- Hearing first-hand accounts from business leaders and entrepreneurs
- Masterclasses from leading employers and brands
- Trips to businesses both locally and nationally, to learn what it's like working in a business.

Entry Level | Pathway to Business

Harpurhey / Wythenshawe | One Year

The skills covered on this course have been chosen to reflect the demands of higher-level courses. We have put the course together in order to wrap it around IT and Business Skills which you will need to progress onto a Level 1 course. At the heart of this course is a unit that allows you to go on a visit for the day, this could lead to the shops or even something as exciting as the zoo for a fun day out.


This course offers opportunities to allow you to have a stepping stone into a Level 1 course, even if your grades were not what you expected. Just remember this college has successful courses available to suit any learner. It offers a taster of two different vocational studies and provides skills to support successful progression route onto higher levels of study.

Level 1 | Introduction to Business

Harpurhey / Wythenshawe | One Year

Working with industry-standard tools and software, this course will help you develop the all-round technological skills required to move onto further studies in business.

You'll explore a variety of transferable and sector specific skills such as organisational skills, research, progression plans and teamwork as well as studying business industry-based projects.



Level 2 | Business Skills with Entrepreneurship

Shena Simon* | One Year

Whether you want to set up your own company, help develop a family business or oversee a department in a large corporation, you'll need the same employability skills and knowledge of the business world to succeed. That's where this course can help.

You'll learn all about how businesses are created and structured, and the impact of different ownership models on both individual departments and the business as a whole. We'll help you to explore all the skills and techniques you need to effectively manage a business, from tracking spending and income to overseeing resources and deciding where they should be allocated.

Alongside all of this, you'll be developing a number of interpersonal skills and qualities that will help you in whatever career path you choose, including providing excellent customer service, being organised and working with others.

You can earn either a Level 2 Certificate or Extended Certificate, depending on the number of units you take, and you'll get the chance to work with large, well-respected businesses in Manchester on special projects.

Level 3 | Business Venture with Entrepreneurship

Shena Simon* | Two Years

If you want to enhance your entrepreneurial skills even further and develop the insight, knowledge and abilities to stand out and succeed in any business situation, then this Level 3 qualification could be just the course for you.

Whether you're learning how to start a company from scratch or how multinational corporations operate, you'll look at a wide range of topics relevant to every aspect of business. You'll take a close look at human resource management and find out how different departments work together to ensure their activities benefit the business as a whole.

We'll also help you to understand globalisation and how it impacts international businesses, and cover a multitude of other topics, such as business law, finance and accounting. You'll even learn about marketing and the different methods used to promote brands.

The overall focus will be ensuring you're ready to start a career in the ever-competitive business world. In your second year you'll have the opportunity to specialise in the area of business that you enjoy and want to pursue, whether that's marketing, finance, law or if you prefer, you can continue to study the overall business landscape.



Level 3 | Professional Marketing and Digital Business Development

Shena Simon* | Two Years

As technology advances and customer needs change, so does the industry and the marketing strategies within it.

Our Professional Marketing qualification looks specifically at digital business setups and allows for you to become specifically qualified in marketing. As businesses evolve with modern, digital strategies, it's important that you learn about the variety of marketing methods available in order to reach out to your target audience.

During this two year course, you'll study advanced techniques to gain the skills necessary to market a modern start-up business.


You'll also learn how to professionally manage business events, which can only be successful if you know how to develop your very own marketing strategy.

We'll help you Accelerate2industry

As soon as you enrol on a Business course, we'll start talking to you about the opportunities that could be open to you in the future. Study a Foundation Degree in Business Management

You'll cover a range of topics, including:

- · Sustainable Development
- · Innovation and Creativity Skills for Business
 - · Accounting and Fintech for Managers
 - · Principles of Strategic Management

This is a two-year course, that allows you to progress onto a oneyear (Top-up) degree to obtain an Honours degree.


Business Development Manager Starting salary: £26,000 Salary with experience: £64,000

- an incubator Hub where our industry partners for Business will come and work with students on their projects, this will also be available for students to use as an office when their industry placement requires them to 'work from home'
- a roof terrace for socialising with friends
- an extended library
- plus IT suites and classrooms.




